

- Tickets and Parking are non refundable
- All gates open at 9AM and not before
- Tickets MUST be worn on outer clothing at all times during the day
- Every person who enters Springdale Race Course must show their pre-purchased general admission ticket or ribbon credential. If a ticket had not been pre-purchased a general admission ticket MUST be purchased on the grounds.
- Any person with a general admission ticket that does not have their hand stamped will be considered to be using a stolen ticket and made to purchase a ticket and get their hand stamped, or be escorted off of the grounds.
- Any person contributing to the falsification of parking credentials and tickets or found in possession of counterfeit tickets will be removed from the premises and prosecuted to the full extent of the law.
- No duplicate tickets will be provided.
- All tailgate parties MUST stay contained within each space. This includes Pop-Up type tents and canopies. Infield, Front Row Paddock, South Rail, and West Rail parking spaces are 9'wideX20'deep.
- No subletting of parking spaces.
- No corporate logos on tents unless prior arrangements have been made with the racing association.
- Nothing over 7' in height is allowed in the infield. This includes vehicles, Pop-Up type tents, canopies and awnings.
- Pegged party type tents are NOT ALLOWED in the infield
- No tents, awnings or canopies of any kind are permitted on Front Row Paddock spaces 1-199
- Pegged party type tents are allowed on South Rail, West Rail and Front Row Paddock spaces 200-297. Please call the CCRA offices if your plans include a party tent on any of these spaces.
- No wheeled vehicles motorized or other with the exception of cars or trucks are allowed
- No pull behind gas or charcoal grills
- No vehicles will be allowed between College Park Rows A&B
- No other tents then the provided 20'X20' tents will be allowed on College Park Rows A&B
- Pop-Up type tents only are allowed on College Park Rows C-E. No other tents will be permitted.
- No flag poles or poles of any kind taller then 15' in College Park
- No Dogs or any other pets
- No loud music
- No unseemly behavior
- All oversize vehicles, vans, campers, Rvs, and buses MUST use Restricted Parking or General Parking
- It is a condition of the issuance of tickets that all attendees shall hold the Carolina Cup Racing Association, its sponsors and beneficiaries harmless for any damage, loss or accident. Failure to honor race policies shall result in expulsion from the grounds and loss of reserved space.
