Directions to Hermitage Farm Shooting Sports:

From Columbia: I-20 east to exit 98 (Camden, Hwy. 521). Turn left toward Camden. Turn right on Black River Road (there will be a Shell Station on the corner). Turn left on Tickle Hill Road. (Do not turn on Hermitage Farm Road). Hermitage Farm Shooting Sports will be on your left.

All shooters must bring eye protection such as shooting glasses or sunglasses. Ear protection will be provided. Guns will be available for a small rental fee. Additional ammunition will be available for purchase, except for .410 ammunition, which will not be provided for the tournament or available purchase.
